



Holiday Homes Booking Policy

Booking Process:

1. Ballots

Bookings for the holiday homes are initially allocated via a ballot process actioned 6 months prior to the intended week of occupancy.

Bookings are for a 7 day period – Sunday 2.30pm to Sunday 10.00am

Expressions of interest for inclusion in a ballot week can be submitted up to 12 months prior to the ballot draw. These expressions can be submitted via:

- *TPAV Web site*
- *Smart phone app*
- *Email to holidayhomes@tpav.org.au*

Only current financial members are eligible for the ballot.

2. Immediate Bookings

Immediate bookings are for vacancies that have not been allocated in the ballot process or when a member has cancelled a booking. These vacancies appear as green on the web site/ Phone app and are booked strictly on a first in best dressed policy.

Bookings are for a 7 day period – Sunday 2.30pm to Sunday 10.00am.

The following is a list of people eligible to request immediate bookings:

- Members – who are currently financial
- Retired Members (who contribute as Outside Members)
- Life Members
- Widows of Police Association members
- Retired Members
- Interstate/ Overseas Police Association members
- Staff members of The Police Association

3. Last Minute - Partial Bookings

Last minute bookings refer to partial bookings of a minimum of 3 nights for vacancies in the leading 2 weeks prior to check in.

Eligibility is the same as Immediate Bookings.
